



Coulson Tough Scholarship Program 2017-2018



Purpose: To provide scholarships for Conroe ISD graduating seniors who are former Coulson Tough students and are enrolling in a 2 or 4 year degree program beginning in the Fall of 2018.

Award Components: Recipients are chosen by the Coulson Tough Scholarship Committee and will each receive a \$1,000.00 scholarship.

Criteria:

1. Applicants must be a current CISD graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
2. Applicants must be former Coulson Tough Flex School student.
3. Applicants must plan to enroll as a full-time student and pursue a 2 or 4 year degree at an accredited college or university.
4. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 GPA and be in good standing with their high school.

Application Process: Applicants must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (printed).
2. Letter of application addressed to the CT Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a **brief** explanation of educational and career goals, as well as biographical information.
3. A minimum of two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers, administrators, or counselors.
4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
5. Personal Essay: In your essay, please answer the following question on a separate sheet of paper:

“Coulson Tough School teaches the following Pillars of Character: Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Generosity, Courage, Kindness, Honesty, Perseverance, and Citizenship. Which do you consider to be your strongest character trait? Describe how this trait has helped you in the past and also how you see it impacting you in the future.”

Deadline: All applications are due by **March 29, 2018**. *All applications and essays will be evaluated by a blind process. Winners will be contacted and posted on our website by April 16, 2018.* Please mail or submit the application in person to:
