

Coulson Tough Scholarship 2023-2024



Purpose: To provide scholarships for Conroe ISD graduating seniors who are former Coulson Tough students and are enrolling in a 2 or 4 year degree program in the United States beginning in the Fall of 2024.

Award Components: Recipients are chosen by the Coulson Tough Scholarship Committee and will receive a \$1,000.00 scholarship.

Criteria:

- 1. Applicants must be a current CISD graduating high school senior in the year of the award.
- 2. Applicants must be former Coulson Tough K-6 School student.
- 3. Applicants must plan to enroll as a full-time student and pursue a 2 or 4-year degree at an accredited college or university in the United States, Fall 2024.
- 4. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 GPA and be in good standing with their high school.

Application Process: Applicants must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form (typed or printed).
- 2. Letter of application addressed to the CT Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a **brief** explanation of educational and career goals, as well as biographical information.
- 3. A minimum of two (2) letters of recommendation from teachers, administrators or counselors.
- 4. A recent unofficial high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 5. Personal Essay: In your essay, please answer the following question on a separate sheet of paper:

"Coulson Tough School teaches the following Pillars of Character: Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Generosity, Courage, Kindness, Honesty, Perseverance/Resilience, and Citizenship. Which do you consider to be your strongest character trait? Describe how this trait has helped you in the past and also how you see it impacting you in the future."

Deadline: All applications are due by **April 19**, **2024**. A blind process will evaluate all applications and essays. Winners will be directly contacted and posted on our website by **April 29**, **2024**.
